

HARRISON COUNTY FAIR BOARD

DIRECTOR EXPECTATIONS

Harrison County Fair Association is comprised of an Advisory/Working board of directors. The purpose of the board is to plan and participate in county fair activities. The board has the direction and control of the association.

The board consist of 20 to 25 directors. Directors must be 18 years or older. Directors must reside in Harrison County, Rockford or Boomer townships in Pott. County. Directors serve a 3 year term with no limit of terms.

New directors will be voted on the board based on their application and commitment to the fair.

All directors MUST volunteer their time at the fair. Directors have a responsibility to participate actively in making decisions on behalf of the Harrison County Fair Association, and must exercise their best judgement while doing so. Directors must remain in good standing with the board by attending the majority of monthly meetings and by conducting themselves in a positive and professional manner towards the fair and its other directors.

Monthly meetings are held the first Monday of each month.

Each director must participate in at least one work committee.
